

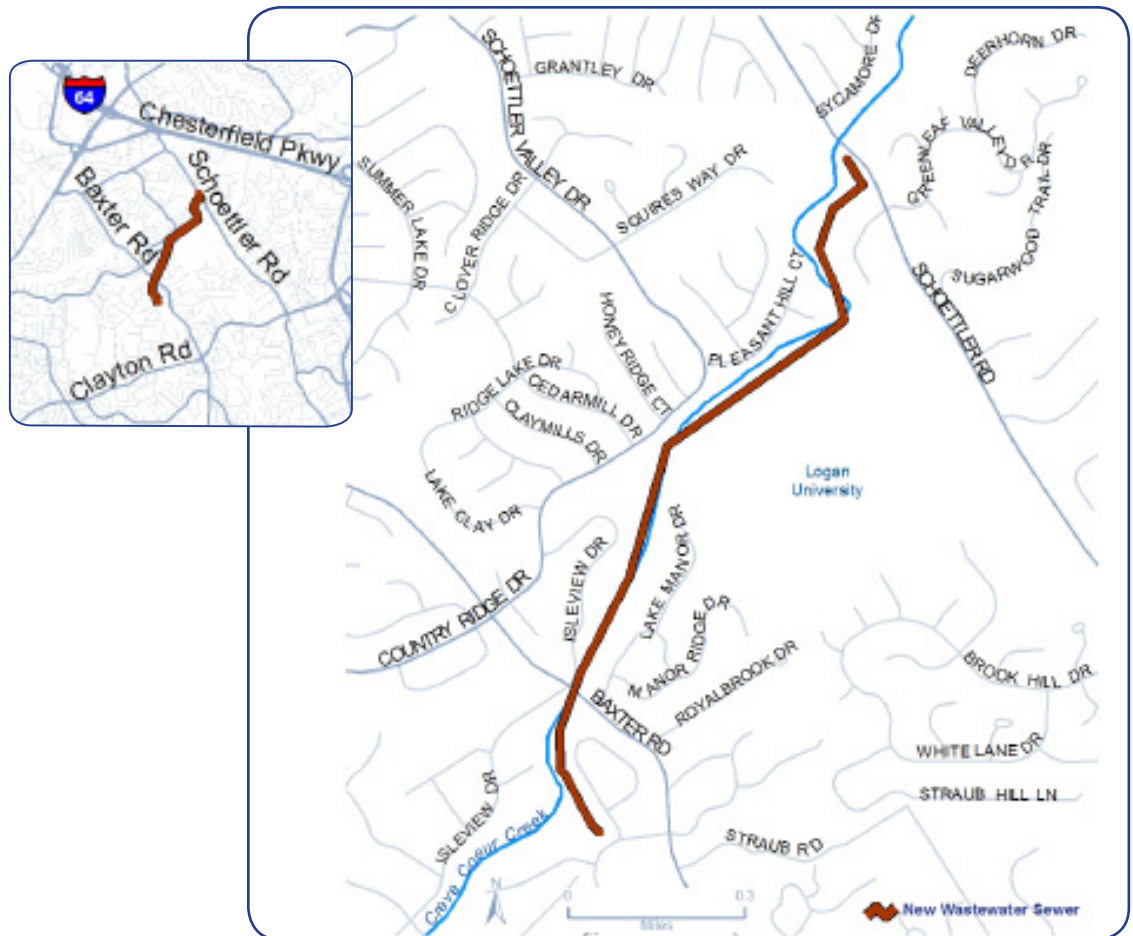

## ABOUT THE PROJECT

The purpose of the project is to alleviate basement backups and sewer overflows by increasing the capacity of the sewer system in the project area.

Work will involve constructing 7,750 feet of 12-24 inch wastewater sewer and eliminating a constructed sewer outfall that currently discharges into tributaries of Creve Coeur Creek during periods of heavy rain.

### WHAT WILL BE DONE?

- Field work to assess current conditions
- Design of sewer improvements
- Construction of sewer improvements

### WHEN?

- Design of sewer improvements will be complete in summer of 2017.
- Construction of sewer improvements is anticipated in 2019.

### WHY?

- Investigate the existing sewer system to determine needed improvements.
- Reduce risk and frequency of basement backups and sewer overflows.

### WHO WILL COMPLETE THE WORK?

- Amec Foster Wheeler in partnership with the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District.
